8.	Competition Format	<p>The 3x3 Basketball competitions shall be organised in accordance with the most recent technical regulations of the “Federation International Basketball Association” (FIBA). In any dispute the English text shall be regarded as authoritative.</p> <p>The programme and duration of competitions are fixed by the Executive Committee in agreement with the Organising Committee and the CTI. The competitions shall last five (5) days and include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> I. Each NUSF may send in a maximum of 2 man's teams and 2 woman's teams. Players in the same team must be from the same university. II. The top 2 teams of Men and Women’s University team will automatically qualified to the 3rd 3x3 Basketball FISU World University League 2017. III. Each team may consist of a maximum of 4 players and 1 Official. The NUSF that will enter a minimum of 1 team is allowed to assign a head of delegation. For extra officials, the OC will charge according to the real expenses. IV. Each country / region MUST bring with them, at their own cost, including all allowances as recommended by the IF/AF concerned, one (1) referee having the national or international license. OC will not pay per diem to Referees brought along by teams. V. The participating country / region shall pay a penalty fee of USD1, 500 to the OC at accreditation if they have not fulfilled their obligation in bringing along referee. VI. All teams must be entered by the NUSF and prioritized in 1 and 2. VII. A maximum of 16 teams in man's and woman's division will be accepted. VIII. Unless the number of entries exceeds 16, one team from each NUSF will be selected. IX. A draw will be conducted by AUSF together with the host to select the teams.

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9.	Registration on 3x3 Planet	All players MUST be registered on the FIBA 3x3 planet platform www.3x3planet.com in order to take part to the tournament.	
10.	Participation & Eligibility	<p>Only competitors who meet the following conditions may take part in the event :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Be a national of the country or region they represent. b. The player should be born from January 1, 1993 to December 31, 1999. c. Students who are currently officially registered as preceding towards a degree or diploma at a university or similar institute whose status is recognized by the appropriate national academic authority of their country or region. d. Former students of the institutions mentioned in c) who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the year preceding the event. 	
11.	Registration Fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. AUSF registration fee at USD 10 per head (for all competitors and officials) for AUSF members and at USD 20 for non-members shall be collected by the CISCA before issuance of the accreditation cards. 	
12.	Participation Fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. The participating countries / regions shall responsible for their own cost of travel to the nearest airport and return. b. The participating countries / regions, upon arrival, shall pay OC the Participating Fees (per person per night for each member of the delegation). c. The amount needs to be paid to OC is USD 60 per night per head. d. The participating countries / regions must confirm their entry with an advance payment of 25% of the participation fees per entered competitor and official. 	
	Insurance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. AUSF and OC shall not responsible for any claim or loss, injury or damage arising from the holding of this Championship. b. All participating country / region MUST have their appropriate insurance to cover travel and participation as these are not the responsibility of the OC nor AUSF.
